

Scarflace Make a scarf necklace

from recycled T shirts





Step 1: Lay T shirt out flat and cut twelve 1" strips lengthwise all the way up to the sleeves. Cut the sleeves into stips also. Step 2: Open the strips up and stretch each one until they are long and narrow as shown.








Step 3: Place all 12 pieces in a loop and tie together with short piece cut from sleeve. Cut loops in half at upper edge. Take the right side and divide into three sections of four strands each. Step 4: Braid the right side strands all the way to the top, leaving about two inches and tie off







Step 5: Turn piece around with open ends down. Match a strand on the right with ones on the left and either stitch together with a needle and thread or tie together with knots. Cut a piece from the upper shirt about 4"x5".







Step 6: Straighten up loops with sewed or tied ends together and wrap strip over as shown and stitch above loops. Fold the strip inside out, so seam is on the inside. You can wear this as one long piece or loop over at neck for a two-layer look. Save sleeves for a different scarflace. Mix and match different colors if wanted. Once you start you will get many different ideas and designs. Most do not require any sewing at all. have fun!
